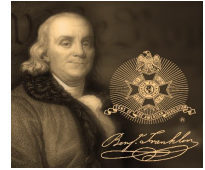

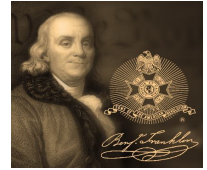
March
