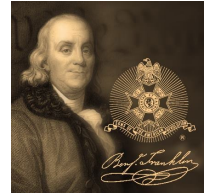

# This Month in Revolutionary War History

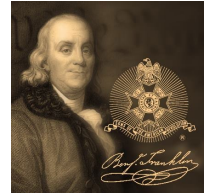
## January
