Patriot Grave Marking – June 19, 2021

June Chapter Meeting will be Grave Markings in Northeast Franklin County. They are scheduled for June 19, 2021 at Noon. The first will be at 4758 Johnstown Road, Gahanna. The second where three patriots will be remembered is at 2591 Darling Road in Jefferson Township/Gahanna. The first is Patriot Mathias Dague Sr. buried at the Johnstown Road location. The second site will remember, Thomas Ayers, John Johnson and Andrew Hanna in the Jefferson Township Cemetery, known as Ayers Cemetery, no more than 4 miles from Mathis will be honored.

The first location is on the east side of SR 62 next to the Barn at Rock Creek Restaurant, just south of the Morse Road/ Johnstown Round About.

The Ohio Society Color Guard will be present with members from Hocking Valley, Cincinnati, Northeast Ohio, and Franklin attending. New State President Troy Bailey has confirmed his attendance. DAR Chapters in the area have also been invited.

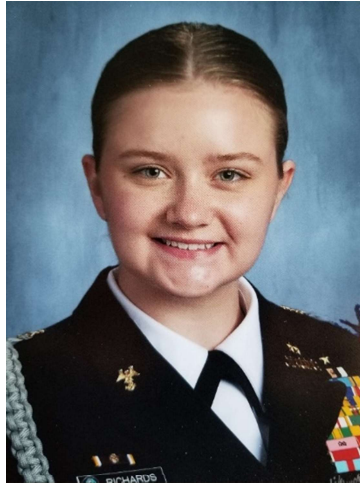


Ashtabula County Grave Marking on May 29. Five Patriots Remembered.
